Before practice day

- Install Bluebook only from the official College Board source.
- Confirm the correct College Board account.
- Complete the test preview and learn navigation tools.
- Choose a quiet 2-hour-14-minute block.
- Prepare the same scratch-work setup intended for test day.

After the practice test

- Record total, section and domain indicators.
- Open My Practice and review targeted questions.
- Classify misses as content, interpretation, pacing or carelessness.
- Redo the question before reading the full explanation.
- Wait until targeted practice is complete before using another full test.

School readiness

The administering school controls the final device, identification, room and accommodation instructions. Follow school communication rather than assuming weekend SAT rules.
